International Psychology Postgraduate Fellowship Program with concentrations in: Human Rights, Policy Development, and Global Humanitarian Relief

The ATOP Meaningfulworld team is excited to announce the launch of its new International Psychology Postgraduate Fellowship Program! The year-long fellowship offers fellows academic and experiential learning experiences in international psychology. Fellows can choose from three concentrations within the program: human rights, humanitarian policy development, and global humanitarian relief. Fellows will explore the role mental health theories and policies play in these humanitarian tracks.

Fellows will have the opportunity to work with various ATOP teams and members and will engage in their own research as well as the organizations research projects. Additionally, they will participate in ATOP Meaningfulworld trainings and workshops, weekly meetings at the United Nations, and humanitarian missions.

Eligibility: Applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Have a master's or doctoral degree* in clinical psychology, counseling psychology, conflict resolution, social work, psychiatric nursing, medicine, law, int relations, or a related field
- Have availability every Thursday to attend meetings *in person* at the United Nations and have availability one other day each week to work *remotely*
- Possess at least a basic knowledge of behavioral science & a dedication to humanitarianism
- Possess strong written and oral communication skills
- Can travel abroad, including possession of a valid passport (those in humanitarian track)

Applications must include a CV, latest transcript, statement of interest, goals, and focus (500 words), and three references with contact information.
